

logen delivers first ethanol shipment to Shell

OTTAWA, ONTARIO, CANADA — Following last July's announcement of an extended commercial alliance with Royal Dutch Shell plc, logen announced Sept. 25 that it had shipped the first 100,000 liters (26,417 gallons) of an initial 180,000 liter (47,550 gallons) cellulosic ethanol order from Shell.

"The sale of this fuel reinforces the new commercial alliance between Shell and logen announced this summer," said Jeff Passmore, logen executive vice-president. "It is part of our focus on accelerating the deployment of next generation biofuels."

The ethanol was produced from wheat straw at logen's Ottawa, Ontario, Canada, demonstration facility.
